

2021 Blount County Schools Summer School (Grades 7-12)

Registration Form Due: May 19, 2021 (Return to your Home School)

Summer School Dates: June 1 to June 30, 2021

Summer School Time: 7:30 A.M. to 2:30 p.m.

Summer School Locations for ALL Blount County Students: Hayden High School, Southeastern School, or Susan Moore High School.

Students attending Blount County Schools' 2021 Summer School are subject to the policies of the Blount County Board of Education including dress code and cell phone policies. Enrollment in the 2021 Blount County Summer School is limited to students who attend a Blount County, Alabama, school.

Guidelines (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

1. Students must begin work on June 1, 2021.
2. Students must attend daily. Students will be allowed one excused absence/check-out/check-in. Students who exceed one absence may be withdrawn from the summer school program.
3. Students will be served lunch daily. Students will also have one snack time each day. Vending machines will be available to students.
4. Students may bring a snack each day if they choose. No outside drinks are allowed on campus.
5. Doors will open at 7:20 a.m. each day. Students will be considered tardy after 7:35. Students who exceed 1 tardy to school may be withdrawn from the summer school program.
6. Students who violate campus traffic rules may have driving privileges revoked.
7. Students should be picked up no later than 2:45 p.m. each day.
8. Students who refuse to follow school rules and Board policies will be asked to leave and will be withdrawn from the summer school program.
9. Students will be allowed to make-up as many credits as possible; however, there is no guarantee that students will be able to recover all credits needed to maintain graduation status.
10. The school principal and/or guidance counselor at a student's home school must approve all course enrollments.
11. Registration forms are due by May 19th. If a child is in doubt regarding 2nd semester failure, it is best to complete the registration form. In the event a student does not need summer school after final grades are calculated, the student will be removed from the summer school roster.
12. All summer school instruction will be conducted on the school campus.

This Summer School Program is a Credit Recovery Program. Regular semester grades will be averaged with summer school grades, and the total scaled to the maximum number of allowable points. (Students with averages of 40 or below must make up the entire course content; students with 40 or higher may recover standard-specific content for credit.)

Supply List: Pens and or pencils, a notebook, calculator for math classes

The highest grade a student may earn in credit recovery is a 70.
